At the end of the course, customers will have achieved a level of proficiency in the following areas:

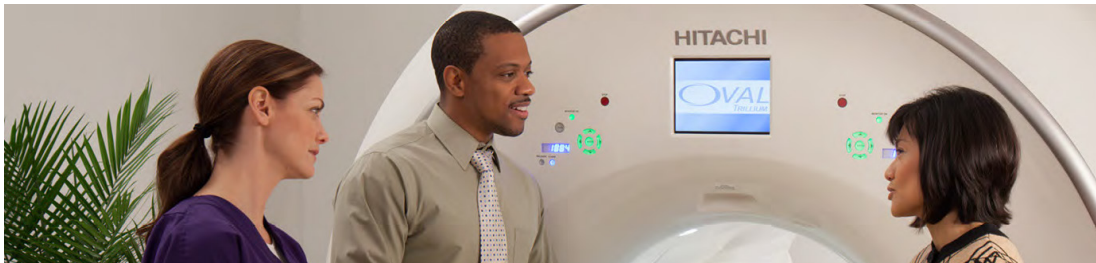
- Physics

THE CT CURRICULUM

The Hitachi Institute for CT Technologists provides a 3-day training series that includes a lecture and hands-on training on one of our in-house CT scanners, as well as a 2-day CT registry review class consisting of a test pre and post lecture.
